This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to responsibly sell, serve or supply alcohol.

It applies to all environments where alcohol is sold or supplied, including licensed venues, packaged liquor outlets, and on-site tastings at wineries, breweries and distilleries.

The unit is relevant to all staff involved in alcohol service or sale — including hospitality workers, liquor retailers, cellar door staff, delivery and sales representatives, security staff and licensees — at all levels of responsibility.
