This program is designed to equip participants with the essential knowledge and skills to maintain food safety and hygiene standards in food handling and supervision.

As of December 2023, Tasmanian-based food, catering and retail businesses are required to appoint at least one Food Safety Supervisor (FSS), who has completed training from a Registered Training Organisation (RTO), in two nationally recognised units of competency.

It is mandatory for individuals in food-related industries, such as tourism, hospitality, catering, and retail industries, to have the necessary skills and qualifications to handle food in a safe and hygienic way.

These units equip the food safety supervisor with all the skills that employers want to see, from storage to preparation, display, service, and the disposal of food in a safe and hygienic way. Upon completion of the course, participants will receive a Statement of Attainment to display on their CV.
